1. About this notice

This notice explains how Verde Lawn Care Ltd uses cookies and similar storage or access technologies on its website.

Cookies are small pieces of information stored on, or read from, a browser or device. Similar technologies may include pixels, tags, local storage, software development kits and device identifiers.

2. Who is responsible

Verde Lawn Care Ltd is responsible for its use of website technologies. Questions can be sent to info@verdelawncare.co.uk or by post to the registered office shown on the cover.

3. Current technology list

The cookie-preference centre available from the website banner or footer must identify each current cookie or similar technology, including its name, provider, purpose, category and duration. That live list forms part of this Cookie Notice because technologies can vary by page, browser choice and website update.

Where the preference centre and this general notice conflict about a specific technology currently in use, the more specific information in the preference centre applies.

4. Categories that may be used

Category	Purpose and consent approach
Strictly necessary	Security, network transmission, load balancing, fraud prevention, remembering privacy choices and providing a feature specifically requested by the visitor. Used without consent only where a legal exception applies.
Preferences and functionality	Remembering optional choices or enhancing site features. Used only with consent where the technology is not strictly necessary.
Analytics and performance	Understanding visits, navigation, errors and performance so the website can be improved. Non-exempt analytics are not used before consent.
Advertising and measurement	Measuring campaigns, limiting advertisements or building advertising audiences. Used only after valid consent where required.
Embedded or social content	Loading maps, video, reviews or social-media features supplied by another provider. Consent is obtained before non-exempt storage or access occurs.
Checkout and payment	Supporting secure forms, payment redirection, session continuity or fraud controls. Each technology is treated according to whether it is strictly necessary for the visitor's requested transaction.

5. Consent

Where consent is required, Verde will ask before setting or accessing the relevant technology. Consent must be an informed, positive choice. Merely continuing to browse is not treated as consent.

The website should make rejecting non-essential technologies as straightforward as accepting them. Refusing non-essential technologies will not prevent access to ordinary website content, although an optional embedded feature may remain unavailable until enabled.

Strictly necessary technologies may operate without consent where they are essential for transmitting communications or providing an online feature the visitor has requested. Information about them will still be provided.

6. Changing or withdrawing choices

Visitors can reopen the cookie-preference centre using the website footer or cookie-settings link and can enable or disable non-essential categories at any time.

Withdrawing consent does not affect processing that was lawful before withdrawal. A technology already stored may remain until it expires or is deleted, but Verde will stop using it for the withdrawn purpose where required.

Browser controls can also block or delete cookies. Blocking strictly necessary technology may prevent a requested form, security feature or checkout function from operating correctly.

7. Third-party technologies

Some technologies may be provided by website hosting, analytics, advertising, embedded-content, mapping, communications or payment suppliers. The cookie-preference centre identifies the provider where applicable.

A third party may receive device or usage information when its technology is enabled. Its own privacy information explains how it uses that information. Verde selects and configures suppliers with reasonable regard to privacy and security.

8. Personal information

Where information from a cookie or similar technology identifies or can reasonably be linked to a person, Verde handles it under the Privacy Notice as well as this Cookie Notice.

The Privacy Notice explains purposes, lawful bases, recipients, international transfers, retention and data-protection rights.

9. How long technologies operate

A session technology normally expires when the browser session ends. A persistent technology remains for the duration stated in the cookie-preference centre unless it is deleted earlier.

Verde will not retain information for longer than reasonably necessary for the stated purpose and will review durations when the website or supplier configuration changes.

10. Website updates

Verde may update the technologies used. The preference centre will be updated when the current list changes, and fresh consent will be requested where a material new use requires it.
